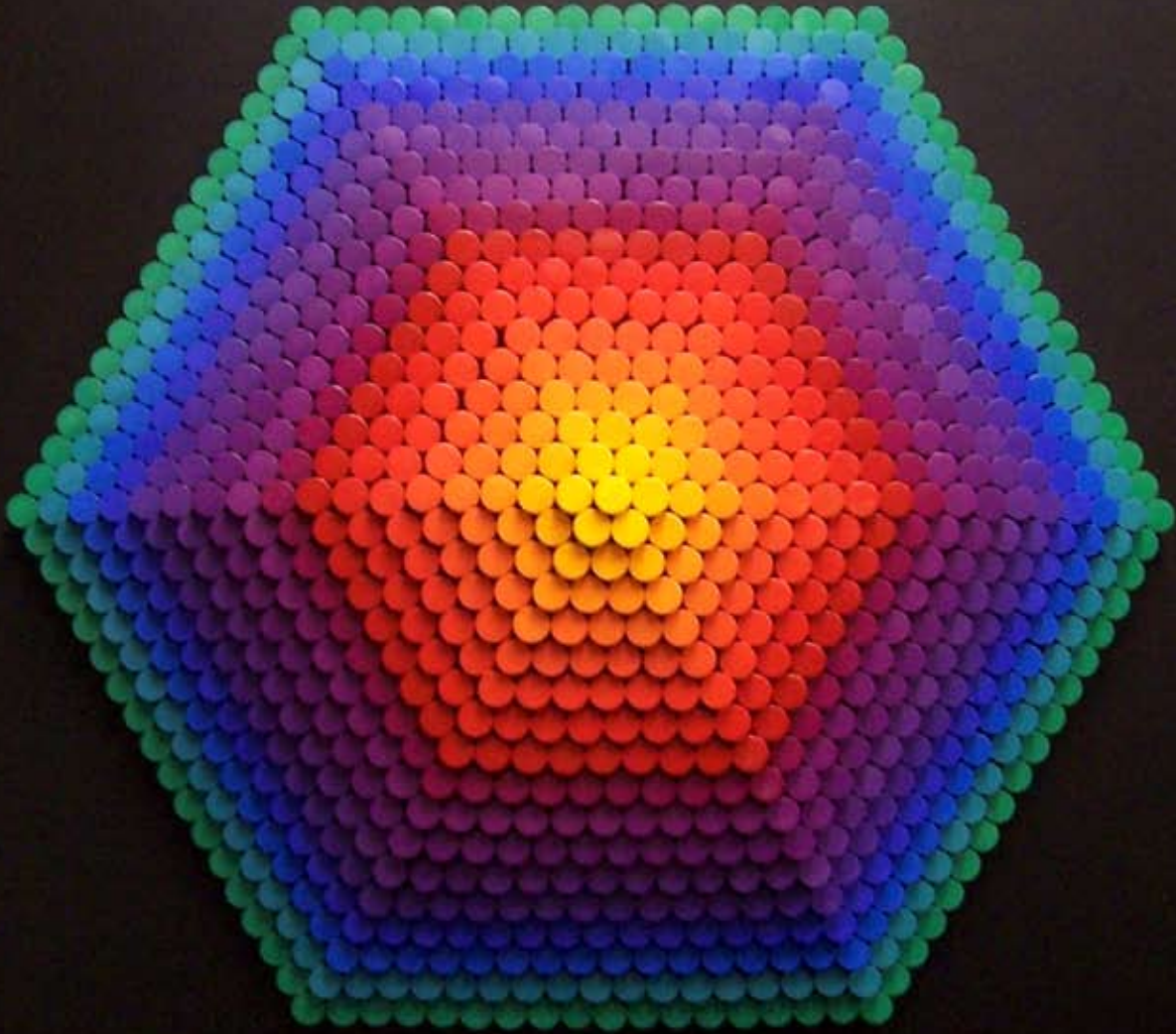

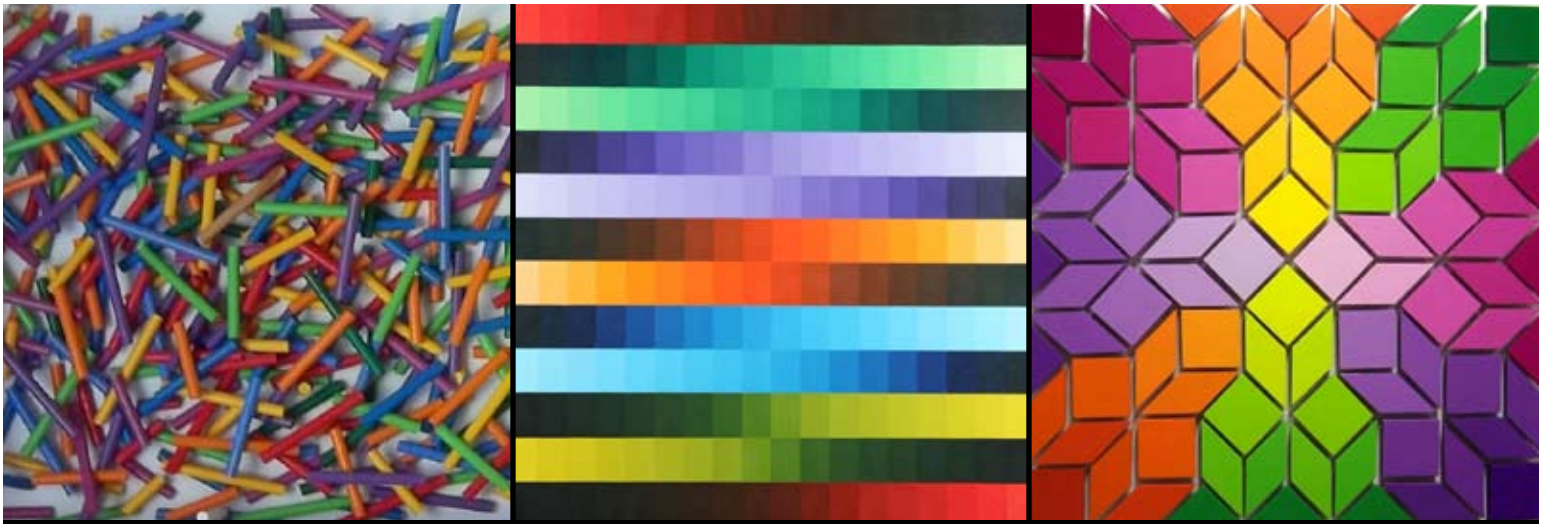

## Stanford Slutsky

Stanford Slutsky works with a deft hand-eye-brush-canvas coordination, applying multiple coats of acrylic paint, free-hand, continually perfecting the bordered forms, until they pass the truest test, that of appearing straight to the eye. His incredible craftsmanship and inexorable, self-imposed standards of quality allow the idea to jump off the canvas into the viewer's mind, with as little interference as possible from technical necessities.

Slutsky was nominated to the Florida Arts Hall of Fame in 1989 and has been the recipient of numerous awards throughout his art career of 30 years. His collection of works is displayed internationally in both the private and corporate world.
